



OET and Tier 2 visas: Only one test now required for both registration and visa purposes

CBLA and Ebek are delighted to inform you that the UK's Home Office announced on the 10th of September, 2019, that doctors, nurses, dentists and midwives applying for Tier 2 (General) visas will no longer need to meet a separate English language requirement where they have done so as part of registering with a healthcare board.

This means that doctors, nurses and midwives who have taken OET will no longer need to take an additional English language test when applying for their visa to work in the UK. Their OET results accepted by the Nursing and Midwifery Council or the General Medical Council will suffice.

The change will apply to all Tier 2 (General) visa applications submitted on or after 1 October.
